What is NRO

Number Resource Organization

- Coalition of RIR
- For carriage of joint RIR activities
 - Technical coordination and services
 - Global policy coordination
 - RIR point of contact and representations
 - Negotiation/Liaison with other bodies (ICANN, IETF, etc...)



What is NRO-NC

- Number Resource Organization- Number Council is one of the NRO components
- Global policy coordination
 - Receive Global policy Proposals
 - Endorse policy outcomes
 - ... All according to defined processes
- 15 members (3 from each registry)

AfrINIC NRO-NC selection process



- 1 member appointed by the board
- 2 members elected by the community
- 3 years terms
- For the first time appointment:
 - First: 3 years term (2005 - 2008)
 - Second: 2 years term (2005 - 2007)
 - Third: 1 years (2005 - 2006)
- All subsequent appointment elections are for 3 years:
Appointed candidate has been reappointed for three years
by the board for a 3 years term (01 - 2007-12-2010)

- Ali Drissa Badiel (2005 – 12/2007) *
- Alan Barrett (2007 – 12/2010)**

2007 NRO-NC election process

- Call for nomination on March 19, 2007
 - Nomination period closed on April 11, 2007
 - Announcement of candidates and opening of comment period on April 16, 2007
 - Comment period closed on April 27, 2007

 - Two candidates for the position
 - **Alain Didier Kla**
 - *ICT Department Manager – Cote d'Ivoire Telecom*
 - **Vincent Ngundi**
 - *IT manager - Kenya Network Information Center (KeNIC)*

Who can vote and How to vote?

Who?

- Anybody from the AfrINIC service region
- No need for proxy

How?

Put a cross in front of the candidate of your choice. Ballot with more than one choice will be considered invalid



Voting operation



- Each candidate have 5 min to present himself and convince people to vote for him.
- Vote of the community
- The Election committee and the observers will count the ballots
- The candidate with the maximum of votes is elected for a three years terms
