Following some observations made, Mr. Ramdhur states that the respondent has no objection to prayer (2) (i) of the praecipe being granted which prayer relates to an Order granting leave to the applicant to intervene as a party in the winding-up application bearing cause number *SC/COM/PET/000508/2025* filed before the Bankruptcy Division of the Supreme Court of Mauritius by *CLOUD INNOVATION LTD* against *AFRICAN NETWORK INFORMATION CENTRE (AFRINIC) LTD (IN RECEIVERSHIP)*.
