BUSINESS OF THE DAY

1. Welcome and roll call

The Chairman, JN, welcomed the members present and opened the meeting at 11:06 UTC.

2. Approval of last Minutes

2.1 dated 23 June 2022

3. Assessment of Appeals

The Committee went through the following Appeals and discussed the evaluation reached.

- 1. Appeal against the last call consensus determination on the Proposal 'AFRINIC Number Resources Transfer Policy-AFPUB-2020-GEN-006-DRAFT02'
- 2. Appeal against the last call consensus determination on the Proposal 'Policy Compliance Dashboard-AFPUB-2021-GEN-003-DRAFT02'
- 3. Appeal against the last call consensus determination on the Proposal 'Abuse Contact Policy Update -AFPUB-2018-GEN-001-DRAFT07'

The Committee made the following observations with respect to the aforementioned three (3) appeals:

i. That save for discussions held on the relevant policy during the Last Call, the appellants failed to provide evidence of any discussion held with the PDWG Co-Chairs or the PDWG with a view of resolving the their disagreement with the decision of the Co-Chairs prior to initiating the relevant appeals;

- ii. Only 3 members commented on the proposal during the last call;
- iii. Save for the *ipse-dixit* reference made to certain names on the appeal documents, there is no evidence e.g. such supporting letters from such individuals supporting those appeals;
- iv. That the policy development processes have been followed by the Co-Chairs

After discussions, the Committee formed the view that the aforementioned appeals do not meet the requirements of the CPM for the reasons stated above.

The Secretariat was requested to share the draft report to the mailing list for the Committee to review and edit, before the Chair may release the same to the Working Group.
