

## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS: AFRINIC ORGANISATIONAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT

## 1. INTRODUCTION

AFRINIC, the African Network Information Centre, is one of the five Regional Internet Registries in the world, ensuring a fair management and distribution of internet number resources in the African region.

AFRINIC is a non-governmental and not-for-profit community driven organisation. The legal structure is a company limited by guarantee under the laws of Mauritius.

The organisation is run on daily basis by around fifty permanent staff headed by a CEO. The oversight of the company management is done by a Board of Directors.

The community is made of resource members (organisations using resources issued by AFRINIC) and community at Large (any individual interested in Internet Number Resources Management).

AFRINIC's mission includes supporting internet technology development and promoting a participatory and multi-stakeholder approach to internet self-governance and maintaining various mailing lists for exchange and discussion between its community members.

AFRINIC would like to invite interested Management Consultants / Management Consulting Firms to express their interest in conducting a qualitative and quantitative diagnostics/assessment of the AFRINIC's current Organisational Health and providing recommendations for improvement.
