

Dr Janvier Ngnoulaye currently works at the University of Yaounde 1 in Cameroon (<a href="www.uy1.uninet.cm">www.uy1.uninet.cm</a>). He is an Assistant Professor at the Department of Computer Science in the Advanced Teachers' Training College (e-learning courses), and an adjunct teacher at the Faculty of Sciences (Security and networking courses). He is also a Cisco Instructor at the Cisco Training Center of Yaounde (ccna and ccna security curriculum). Before joining the University, he worked as a system and network administrator for the Campus at the same University where he gained valuable experience in managing the network (Implementing DNS, Firewall, Web server, remote access, etc.) in Linux, Windows and Unix system.
